What is the Lavendon School Association (LSA)?

The LSA is a registered charity (296830) that is aimed at enhancing the educational experience of the pupils of the school, by assisting in the provision of facilities for education at the school that cannot be covered by the school budget and to provide funds to subsidise educational trips for pupils.

How do we do this?

The LSA plan, organise, facilitate or run events throughout the year. These activities are events such as school discos, school photos, Easter trails around the village, Lucky Numbers lottery, bake sales and many more!

Where does the money go?

Every year the LSA has to raise a minimum of £3500. The LSA then donates £500 to each class, to spend on enhancing the pupils educational experience. The LSA also supports some requests from the school. Past funding has included: a new sound system, reading books, laptop charging equipment, and playground repairs.
